Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers read and distribute Communion @ weekend Masses @ both Webster & Evolve Nursing & Memory Care facilities.

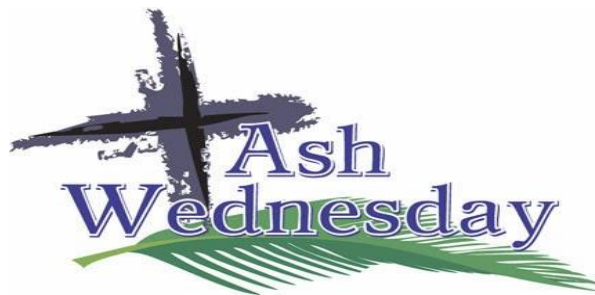
Scheduling is done for three months at a time. There will be sign-up sheets in the Sacristy for the additional services need for our Lenten and Easter rites.
